Mijas Town Council encourage citizens to register on the Padron. The local government aims to increase the registered population in Mijas in order to qualify for more state economic help which is granted according to the amount of registered inhabitants. This means that there would be **more services for Mijas residents and fiscal benefits** for those that are registered. It is very **easy to enrol** on the inhabitant's list and this can be done at any of the Citizen's Advice Offices in La Cala, Las Lagunas and Mijas Village. Any foreigner can register on the local inhabitants list in Mijas and in their home country without having to pay more. Foreigners are also advised to register on the electoral role as this can be done at the same time as registering on the inhabitants list and will enable them to vote in the local elections.
